As a parent/carer I will:

-  support school policies and procedures
-  expect my child to behave in line with the school's expectations

-  keep you regularly informed about general school matters, holding meetings to discuss your child's progress and targets
-  provide appropriate homework for each year group and feedback as necessary
-  provide a broad and balanced curriculum that will meet the needs of each child
-  endeavour to correct and inform you of any unacceptable behaviour from your child
-  support families wherever possible to enable the above

As a child I will:

-  behave well throughout the school day
-  care for other children, respect ourselves and others' rights
-  try my hardest with all my work
-  follow school and classroom expectations
-  wear the correct uniform neatly and with pride
-  do my reading and homework and bring it back to school on time
-  look after school property and my own belongings

Parents and teachers together will:
