Explain what you have learnt, what rating you would give it and whether you would recommend for others to read it too.</p>
<p><b>English</b></p> <p>Write 3 different limerick poems and recite them aloud to the class.</p>	<p><b>Science/DT</b></p> <p>Create a 3D skeleton model. You could use card, plastic cutlery, toothpicks, cotton buds etc.</p>	<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>Show photographic evidence/explain how you have overcome a fear.</p>	<p><b>English</b></p> <p>Describe, in a paragraph each, Jack and Rose from our core text ‘The Tunnel’ by Anthony Brown. Include expanded noun phrases about appearance and personality.</p>
