

English

In English this half-term we will be learning to write instructions on how to make a mechanism linking to our previous learning in DT.

We will then be writing report leaflets based on the Bronze Age which we will be learning about in our History lessons.

Pupils will learn to use a range of features in their writing:

- Heading and subheadings
- The perfect tense
- Embedding commas to separate items in a list

Maths

As mathematicians, pupils will learn about:

Multiplication and Division

- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables
- Multiply and divide using the multiplication tables that they know, 2-digit by 1-digit.

Fractions

- Compare and order unit fractions.
- and compare lengths.
- Place fractions of a whole on a number line.
- Represent equivalent fractions as bar models.

Science

As scientists, pupils will learn to: Describe why different animals, including humans, have different diets

Pupils will be taught to:

- Identify appropriate diets for different animals
- Describe the main food groups
- Describe the role of the skeleton in humans
- Describe the role of muscles in humans
- Plan their own healthy menu

Computing

As computer scientists, pupils will learn about: Making Music.

Pupils will:

- Think about how music makes them feel
- Explore rhythms and patterns
- Find out how music can be used
- Learn about notes and tempo
- Create digital music
- Review and edit music

Online Safety

- Pupils will think about how someone's feelings can be hurt by what is said online.

Music

As musicians, pupils will learn about: A reggae song

- Listen and Appraise the song Three Little Birds and other songs.
- Learn and/or build on your knowledge and understanding about the interrelated dimensions of music.
- Combining singing, body percussion and instruments to build a performance.

Curriculum Overview

Spring Term 1



Spanish

As linguists, pupils will learn about Spanish phonics. They will learn:

- the Spanish alphabet.
- the 15 Spanish sounds with their corresponding graphemes.

History

As historians, we will look at the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Bronze Age.

Pupils will:

- Place key events on a timeline
- Explore how life changed in the Bronze Age
- Identify key civilisations
- Compare Stone Age and Bronze Age tools, housing and clothing
- Find out how bronze was made

Art

In Art this half term we will be exploring print making. We will discuss artist Frances Hatch and how her curiosity for the environment influences her creative work.

We will experiment with:

- Natural materials
- Natural pigments
- Cyanotypes

PE

As physical educationalists, pupils will learn about:

Dance, Balance and Ball Skills:

In Dance pupils will learn and develop shapes and circles and create sequences of movement with these through partnering and artistry.

During balance and ball skills, the children will develop and apply their dynamic balance on a line and ball skills through focused skill development sessions, healthy competition, cooperative games and Personal Best challenges.

As theologians, pupils will learn about:

Big Question: Could Jesus really heal people?

- Were these miracles or is there some other explanation?

PHSCE: Children will learn about: Dreams and Goals
