Children will explore and write their own **creative and dramatic dilemma stories.**

Using example texts, pupils will learn to write:

- Character descriptions
- Setting descriptions
- A dilemma
- Problems
- Resolutions

We will then write our own **limerick poems** with rhyming words.

Maths

As mathematicians, pupils will learn about:

Length and Perimeter

- Measuring using rulers and metre sticks.
- Understanding mm, cm and m.
- Finding equivalent lengths
- Calculating the perimeter of 2D shapes.

Shape

- Angles
- Perpendicular and parallel lines
- Identifying, drawing and making 3D shapes

Science

As scientists, pupils will learn about:

Living things including humans.

- Animals and their diets (carnivores, herbivores, omnivores)
- Animal skeletons (how they move)
- The name of bones in the human skeleton
- How the human arm functions using joints and muscles that contract and relax with movement.

Computing

As computer scientists, pupils will learn about:

Using Scratch to program movement of a sprite.

Scratch uses colourful, drag-and-drop blocks to create scripts, making coding visual and fun.

As part of our Computing Safety Unit we will discuss:

- Online reputation and digital footprints.
- Self-image and identity online

Music

As musicians, pupils will first listen to, appraise and learn to sing a variety of songs including our Spring 2 song: "The Dragon Song" which explores the story of Lesley the Dragon who is in search for some new friends.
