

## English

As authors, pupils will write their own haiku poems and write recounts based on their core texts about the Stone Age, as well as their trip to Butser Farm.

Our grammar focus will focus on using expanded noun phrases, prepositions and adverbs.

Reading skills pupils will focus on are:

- Retrieving information, understanding unfamiliar words, summarising key facts and making inferences.

## Maths

As mathematicians, pupils will learn about:

Multiplication and Division

- Recognise, make and add equal groups.
- Use arrays.
- Identify numbers in the 2 times table.
- Make connections between the 5 and 10 times tables.
- Develop understanding of sharing and grouping.
- Learn to multiply and divide by 3, 4 and 8.
- Make connections between the 2/4/8 times tables.

## Science

As scientists, pupils will learn about:

Forces and Magnets

- Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet
- identify some magnetic materials.
- Observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others.
- Compare how things move on different surfaces.
- Notice that some forces need contact between 2 objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance.

## Computing

As computer scientists, pupils will develop their understanding of digital devices, focusing initially on inputs, processes and outputs.

Pupils will also learn:

- How a digital device works.
- The parts of a digital device.
- How digital devices help us.
- How different digital devices are connected.
- How computers are connected.
- What our school network looks like.

## Music

As musicians, pupils will learn about:– the language of music through playing the glockenspiel. The learning is focused around exploring and developing playing skills through the glockenspiel.

## Spanish

As linguists, pupils will learn:

- To describe the colour of some animals and to name their favourite colour.
- About 'The Three Wise Men' Christmas tradition in Spain.

## History

As historians, pupils learn about:

The Stone Age

- What Britain looked like in the Stone Age.
- How they used tools to hunt.
- Looking archaeological sources to help us learn more about the Stone Age era (for example photographs of cave paintings)
- A visit to Butser Ancient Farm to learn how people settled in the Stone Age.

## DT

In DT this term, pupils will create their own moving mechanisms using levers.

Pupils will:

- Identify objects with mechanisms.
- Understand what 'pivot' means.
- Use a range of materials to make pivots.
- Create their own mechanism with levers and linkages.
- Evaluate their work.

## PE

As physical educationalists, pupils will learn about: social skills

Interpersonal skills pupils will focus on are:

- Praising and encouraging others in their learning.
- Show patience and support others listening carefully to them about their work.
- Share and tell others about your ideas.
- Organise roles and responsibilities.
- Cooperate well with others.

Physical skills pupils will focus on are:

- Dynamic balance: Jumping and landing.
- Static Balance: Seated.

## RE & PHSCE

As theologians, pupils will learn about:

RE: Christianity

Big Question: Has Christmas lost its true meaning?

- Exploring what Christmas means to the children and the real meaning for Christians.

PHSCE: Celebrating Difference

Children will learn to:

- Understand that everyone's family is different
- Know what 'bullying' is and what to do if they are being bullied or are a witness to bullying
- Recognise that words can be used in hurtful ways
- Can talk about a time when their words affected someone's feelings
