

What should your poster look like?:

- It should have the name of the language (in English and in the actual language, if different)
- It should have **some words or expressions** on that language (hello, thank you, how are you?...)
- Use **pictures** or translate them into English so those who don't speak the language can understand.
- Make it **colourful** and in **A4 paper**
- Insert a **flag** of the country where that language is spoken.
- You can make two posters if you want.
