

English

The children will be focusing on the skill of poetry- specifically Kennings. Children will learn the skill of stanzas, rhythm, structure and emotive language. Children will also focus on being able to write an autobiography with the grammar focus of: Appropriate choice of pronoun or noun across sentences

The grammatical difference between plurals and possessive –s . e.g. The cows in the field –plural. The cow’s nose- possessive

Reading skills pupils will focus on are:

- Guided reading practicing skills of, reading, comprehension, decoding, inference, tonal and enunciation focus and retrieval.

Maths

As mathematicians the children will,

- Learn to round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and a 1000
- Read and solve problems involving Roman Numerals.
- Add and subtract numbers with up to 4 digits.
- Multiply larger numbers together.
- Solve multistep problems with the above.
- Learn the 6, 7, 9 times tables.

Science

As Scientists the children will,

- Identify how sounds are made.
- Recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.
- Recognise that sounds travel.
- Find patterns between the pitch of a sound.
- Find patterns between the volume of a sound.

Computing

In computing, the children will learn about online bullying and continue to be educated on online safety:

- Children will be taught the different types of media online. I can explain the different features of different media I can simply describe what bullying online may look like on these different forms of media.
- We will also consolidate our understanding of networks and how information is published on the World Wide Web.

Music

As musicians, the children will learn about the language of music through playing the glockenspiel. Children will explore and develop the skills required to play the glockenspiel.

Spanish

As linguists, pupils will learn:

- to say which languages they speak.
- about 'The Christmas Tree' and how to describe it in Spanish.

Geography

As geographers, the children will:

- understand where we import and export goods from.
- Develop their locational knowledge of emerging economies (BRIC and MINT economies)
- Research a country which has an emerging economy such as China, Brazil, India etc
- To describe and understand key aspects of trade links.
- Use fieldwork to investigate where products in the classroom have been imported from.

Art

The children are introduced to the genre of still life as an old art form and also one which is still enjoyed by many contemporary artists.

Pupils revisit and develop their drawing (and looking) skills using observational drawing of physical objects, and then go on to explore a project, either working in collage, photography and paint, clay relief, or graphic still life.

Along the way children consolidate and develop their understanding of how we can use line, shape, colour, texture, form and composition to make their work.

PE

In Physical Education the children will learn to:

- Cooperate well with others and give helpful feedback.
- Help organise roles and responsibilities and I can guide a small group through a task.
- Show and tell others about my ideas.
- Show patience and support others listening carefully to them about our work.
- Help, praise and encourage others in their learning.

RE & PHSCE

PHSCE: Celebrating Difference
Children will understand the concept of judging people by their appearance of first impressions. They will explore more about bullying, including online bullying and what to do if they suspect or know that it is taking place.
