

## English

As authors we will read and retell the fictional story, 'King Jack and the Dragon,' and 'Amy Wu and the Patchwork Dragon'.

Using these texts, pupils will learn to write:

- Using finger spaces, capital letters and full stops
- By sounding out independently to spell simple words
- Using adjectives to describe and extend sentences
- To sequence sentences to form a short narrative using joining words (and, but, so, because)

Reading skills pupils will focus on are:

- Sounding out independently to decode
- Discussing the title of a text, word meanings and comprehension for understanding

## Maths

As mathematicians, pupils will learn about: Number.

Place Value (within 20):

- Counting forwards and backwards up to 20
- Read and write numbers to 20
- Identify more one and one less of a number
- Identify and represent numbers using objects, pictures and a number line

Addition and Subtraction (within 20):

- To know number bonds to 10 and 20
- To identify tens and ones
- To use resources to add and subtract 2 numbers
- To record using + - and = symbols
- To solve addition and subtraction problems

## Science

As scientists, pupils will learn about: Seasons: Winter.

Pupils will be taught to:

- Observe changes across the four seasons (winter)
- Observe and describe weather associated with the four seasons and how day length varies (winter)

Scientific Enquiry Skills:

- To gather and record data
- To observe closely and use equipment
- To ask and answer simple questions

## Computing

As computer scientists, pupils will learn about: Personal security and digital painting.

Pupils will be taught to:

- Describe what different tools do
- Use the shape tool and line tools
- Explain why they choose tools
- Use a computer independently to paint a picture
- Understand the importance of passwords

Basic Computing skills:

- To log on and off a computer
- To remember a username and password
- To access and explore an application
- To use and develop mouse skills

## Music

As musicians, pupils will learn to: Introduce tempo and dynamics.

Pupils will:

- Use their voices expressively to sing songs, chants and rhymes
- Learn how music makes the world a better place.

## Continuous Provision

- Starting with simple movements and gradually adding more difficult ones
