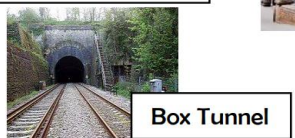


Knowledge Organiser Year 2 history: Who is Isambard Kingdom Brunel and why is he significant?

Infrastructure	Bridges, tunnels, railways, train stations, factories.
Industrial Revolution	A time when Britain started to build and use more factories.
Railway	A type of path for trains. It is made with both wood and metal
Box tunnel (a)	an underground passageway, dug through soil, earth or rock.
Suspension bridge	A bridge that is supported from above by cables.
Viaduct	a bridge made up of several small spans.
colliery	A coal mine.
