Using this text, pupils will learn to write:

Reading skills pupils will focus on are:

- Applying knowledge of words to read and understand unfamiliar language
- Discuss authors' use of language
- Draw inferences and make predictions
- Read and discuss a range of genres and texts

## Spanish

As linguists, pupils will learn to:
