A relative pronoun is a word that connects a dependent (relative) clause to a noun or pronoun, providing additional information about it within a sentence.

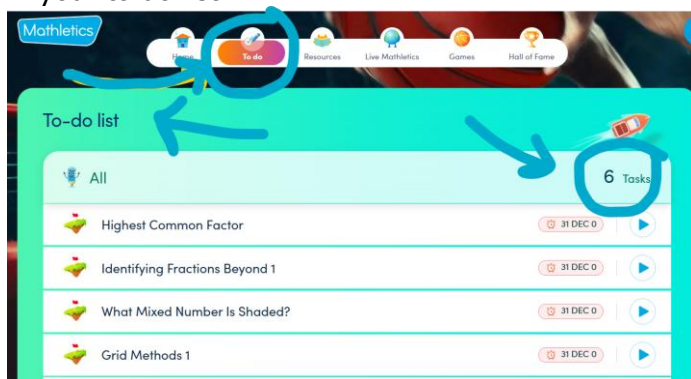
Who	Refers to people The person who won is my friend.	Why	Indicates reason The reason why she cried is unclear.

Which	Refers to animals or things The book, which is on the table, is mine.	Whose	Indicates possession I know a boy whose father is a pilot.
