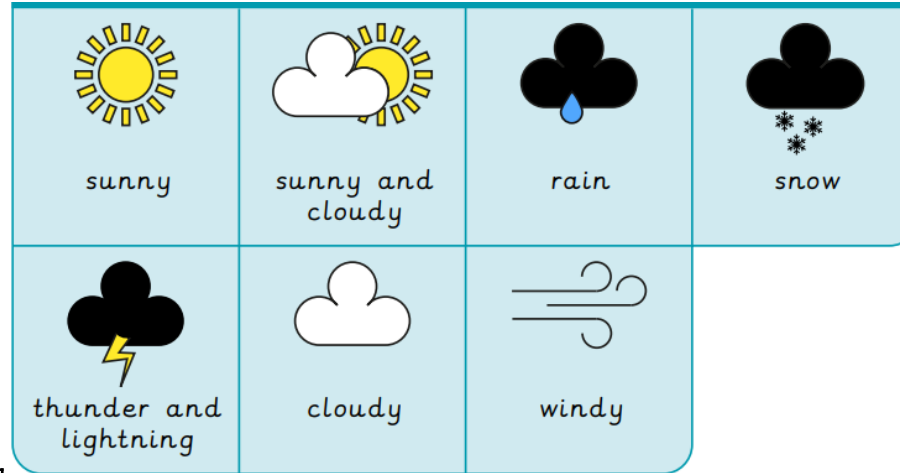


Knowledge Organiser Year 1 Geography: What is the UK weather like?

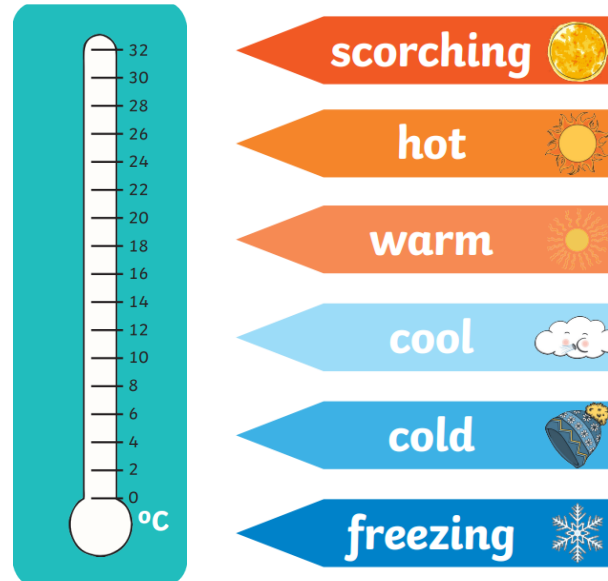

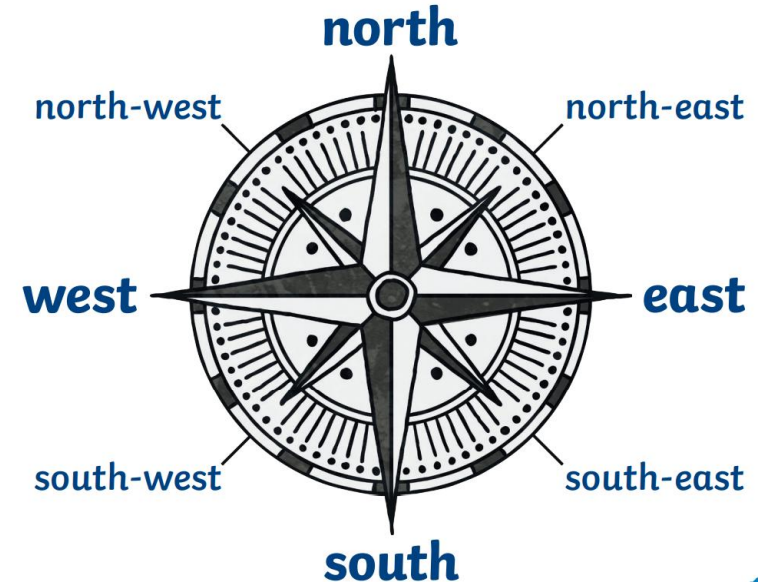

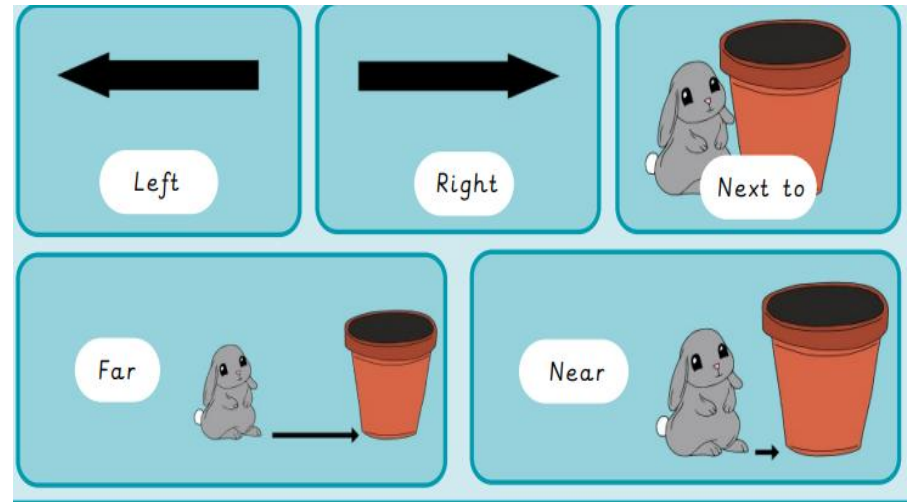
Key Vocabulary



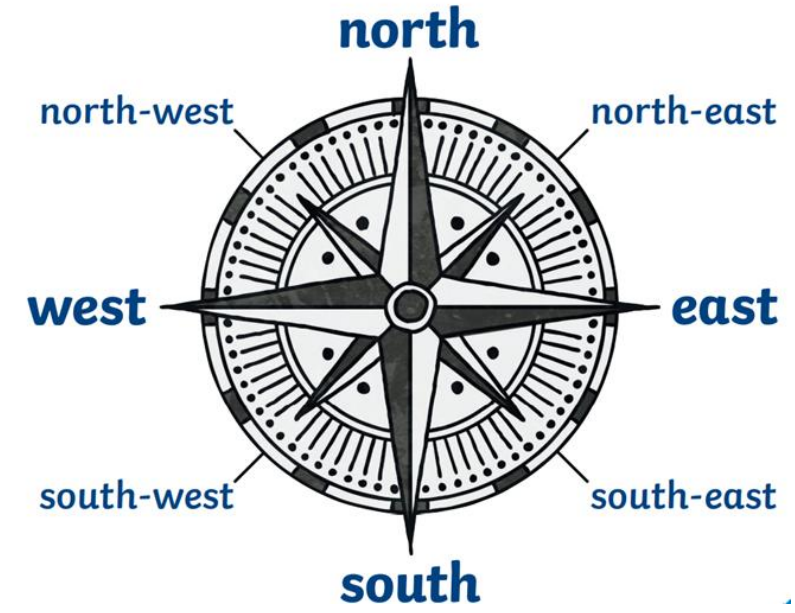

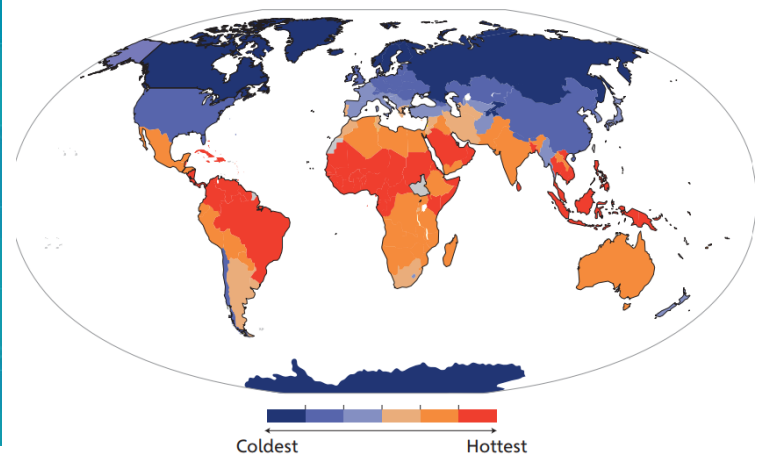
