And the dish ran away with the spoon



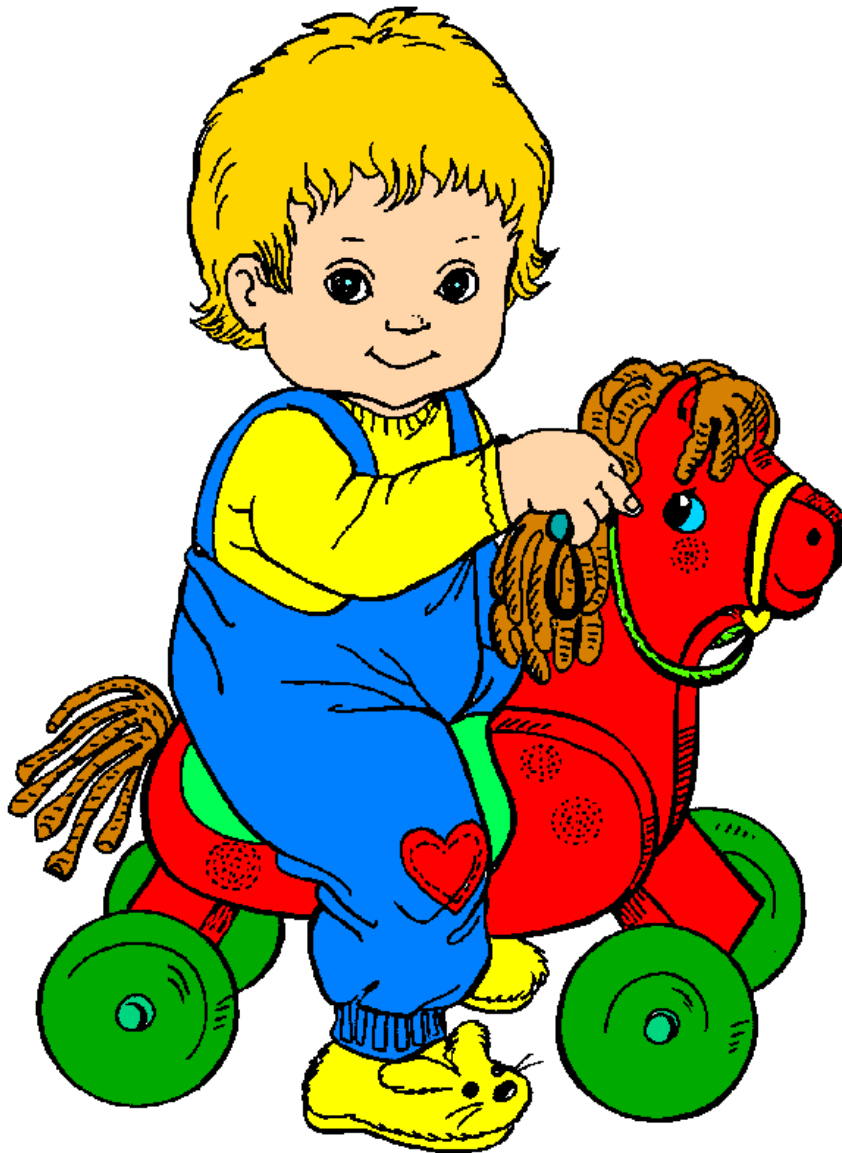
## Hickory Dickory Dock

Hickory dickory dock



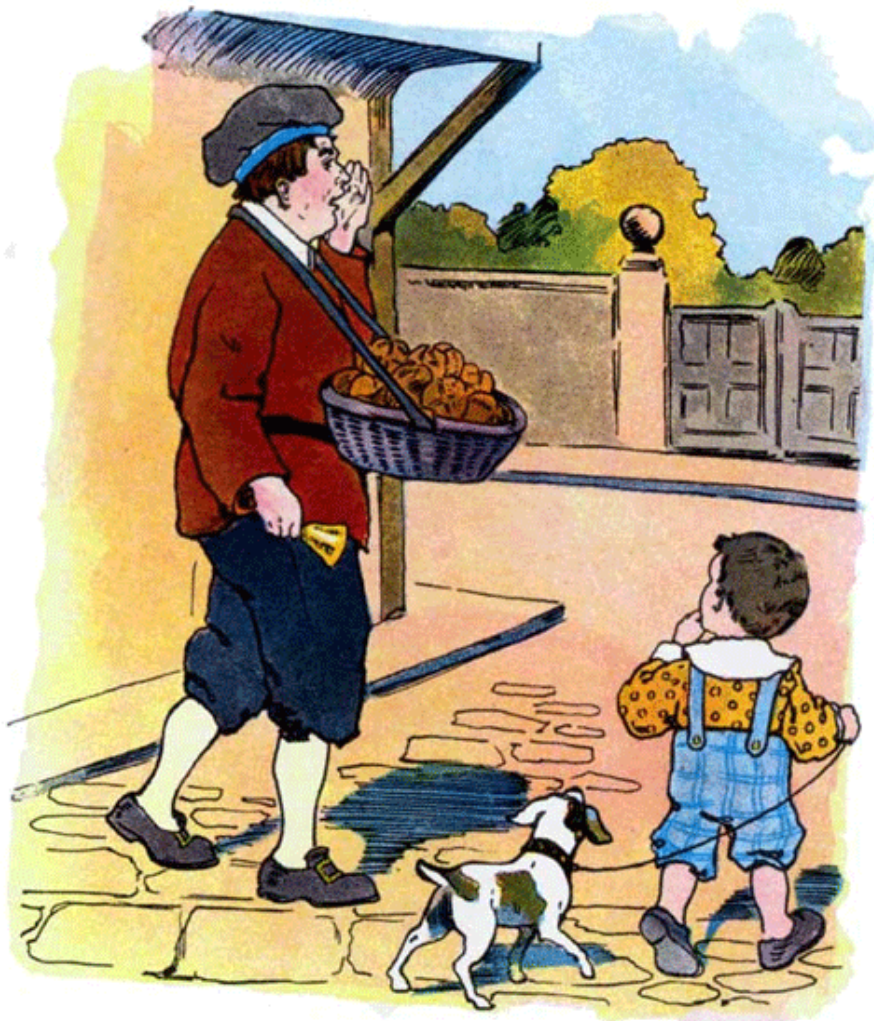
## Horsey Horsey

Pop! Goes the weasel

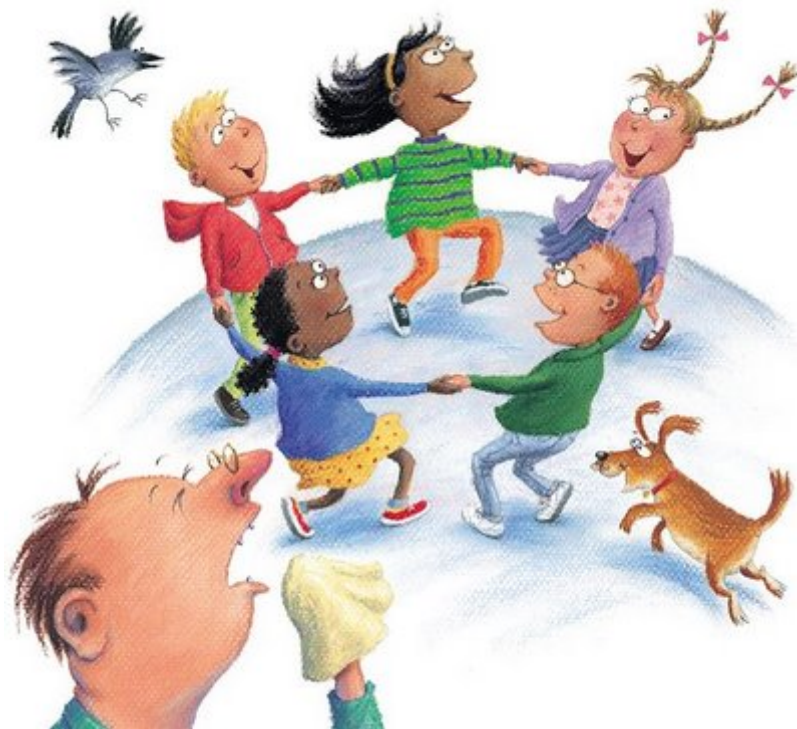
Half a pound of tuppenny rice

With a One...two...three!



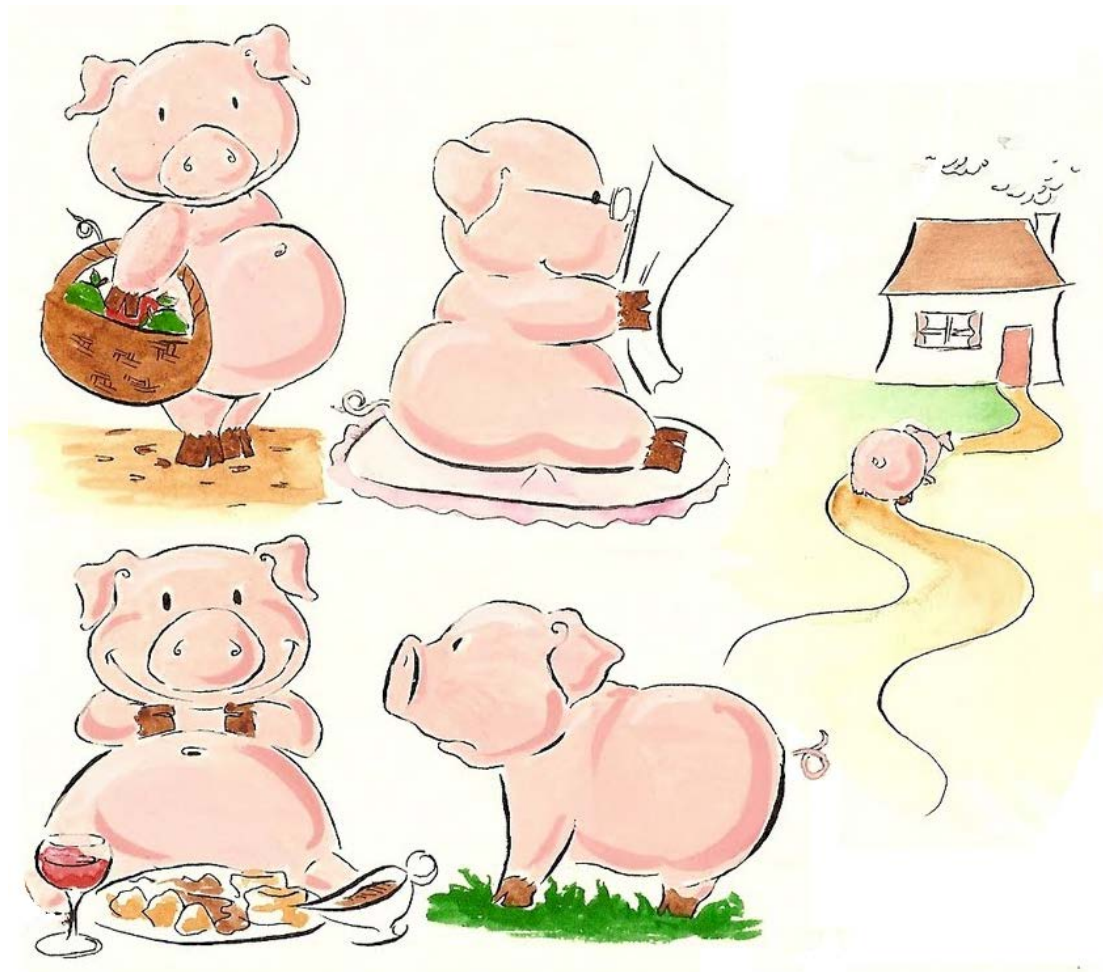
## See Saw Margery Daw

Wee wee wee, all the way home



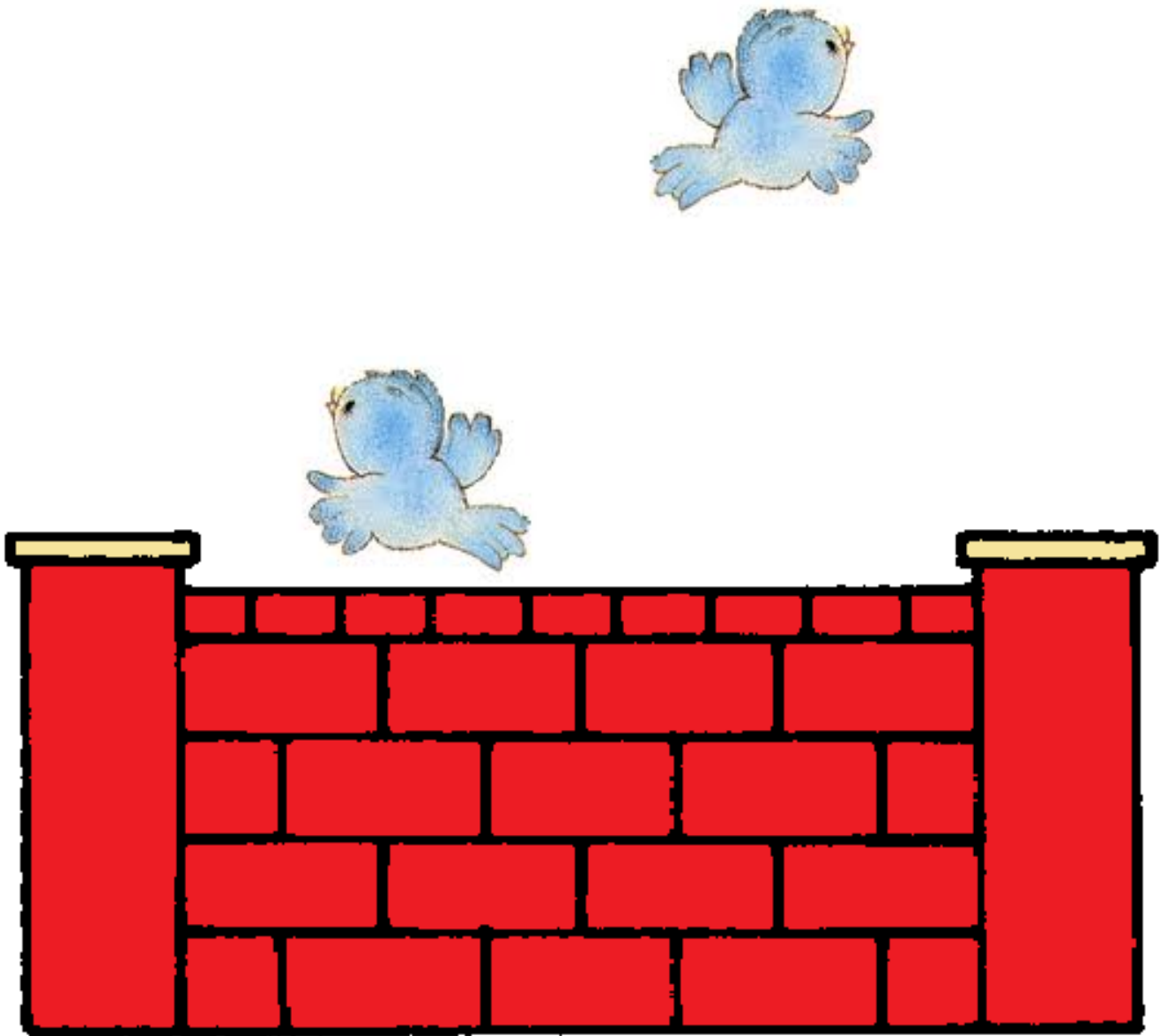
## Twinkle Twinkle Little Star
