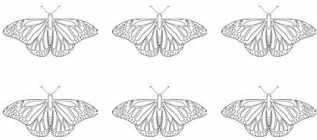

Fractions

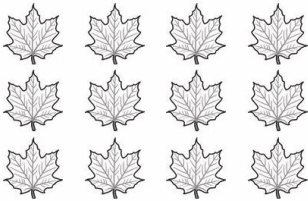
Colour $\frac{1}{2}$ of the butterflies.
