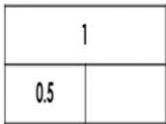

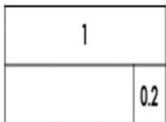

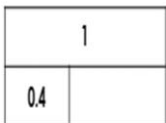
1. Fill in the missing numbers and draw lines to match the bar models and number sentences.
